

ACADEMIC COURSE LOAD POLICY

A typical full-time load is 30 credit hours for the academic year. This, in conjunction with the Four-Year Graduation Guarantee (<https://www.walsh.edu/guarantee.html>), ensures timely progress towards degree completion. Students are classified as full-time if they register for 12 credit hours or more in a given semester. No student is permitted to enroll for more than 19 semester hours without permission of the student's faculty advisor.¹ See Registration Procedures (<http://catalog.walsh.edu/undergraduate/academic-policies-procedures/registration-procedures/>) for information on submitting a request to override the credit hour maximum.
